



Florida's Spring 2021 Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grades Announced

Orlando, Florida, April 29, 2021— [The Leapfrog Group](#), a national nonprofit representing hundreds of the nation's most influential employers and purchasers of health care, driven in Florida by The Florida Alliance for Healthcare Value, announced today the [spring 2021 Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grades](#).

The independent grading system assigns "A," "B," "C," "D," and "F" letter grades to general acute-care hospitals in the U.S. based on their ability to protect patients from avoidable errors, injuries, accidents, and infections.

In Florida, 179 hospitals were graded, and 76 earned an "A," 48 earned a "B," 53 earned a "C," 2 earned a "D," and 0 earned an "F."

"Our members watch the Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade closely because we know how critical they are to the lives and health of people throughout Florida," said Ashley Tait-Dinger, Director of Analytics, Alternative Payment Models and Finance, Florida Alliance for Healthcare Value. "We care deeply about our hospitals, a point brought home to us by the pandemic, and we hold them to the highest standards because we entrust them with our lives."

Congratulations to the two Florida hospitals that have received an "A" Safety Grade every year since 2012 – AdventHealth Daytona Beach and Memorial Hospital Miramar.

Developed under the guidance of a National Expert Panel, the Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade uses up to 27 measures of publicly available hospital safety data to assign grades to more than 2,700 U.S. hospitals twice per year. The Hospital Safety Grade's methodology is peer-reviewed and fully transparent, and the results are free to the public.

"The Leapfrog Group commends all hospitals and health care workers in Florida who saved patients throughout the pandemic," said Leah Binder, president and CEO of The Leapfrog Group. "As we move forward, we will never forget that the safety of the patient is the first priority."
