





## Leapfrog Announces Florida's Spring 2022 Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grades

**Orlando, Florida, May 10, 2022** – The Leapfrog Group, a national nonprofit representing hundreds of the nation's most influential employers and purchasers of health care, driven in Florida by the Florida Alliance for Healthcare Value, announced today the spring 2022 Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grades.

The independent grading system assigns an "A," "B," "C," "D," or "F" grade to all general hospitals across the U.S. based on over 30 national performance measures reflecting errors, accidents, injuries, and infections, as well as systems hospitals have in place to prevent harm.

In Florida, 182 hospitals were graded, and 64 earned an "A," 55 earned a "B," 60 earned a "C," 2 earned a "D," and 1 earned an "F."

"Hospital safety is now more important than ever. A hospital's sustained commitment to patient safety and healthcare quality saves lives," said Ashley Tait-Dinger, the Florida Alliance's Director of Analytics, Alternative Payment Models and Finance. "By using the Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade, patients and their families can make the best selection for where to seek care."

The Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade is the only hospital ratings program based exclusively on hospital prevention of medical errors and harm to patients. The grading system is peer-reviewed, fully transparent, and free to the public. Grades are updated biannually in the fall and in the spring.

"Patients in Florida deserve to know which hospitals are safest, so they can make an informed decision to protect themselves and their loved ones when seeking care," said Leah Binder, president and CEO of The Leapfrog Group. "We're excited to celebrate those hospitals in Florida that uphold high standards of patient care. This community should be proud."
