





Marking the 10th Anniversary: Leapfrog Group Announces Fall 2022 Hospital Grades for Florida

Winter Springs, Florida, November 16, 2022 – Marking the tenth anniversary of the Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade, the Leapfrog Group, an independent national watchdog organization representing the nation's most influential employers and purchasers of health care, driven in Florida by the Florida Alliance for Healthcare Value, announced the <u>fall 2022 Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grades</u>.

The Leapfrog Group has a 10-year history of assigning letter grades to general hospitals throughout the United States, based on a hospital's ability to prevent medical errors and harm to patients. The grading system is peer-reviewed, fully transparent, and free to the public. Hospital Safety Grade results are based on more than 30 national performance measures and are updated each fall and spring.

In Florida, 183 hospitals were graded, and 72 earned an "A," 53 earned a "B," 55 earned a "C," 3 earned a "D," and 0 earned an "F."

Congratulations to AdventHealth Daytona Beach for receiving an "A" Safety Grade every year for the past decade since 2012.

"The Leapfrog Hospital Safety Grade enables unprecedented transparency, driving improvements, and empowering patients for the past ten years," said Ashley Tait-Dinger, Director of Analytics and Alternative Payment Models at the Florida Alliance for Healthcare Value. "We are proud to represent hospitals in our community that are prioritizing the safety of their patients. Florida's hospitals should continue to uphold high standards of patient care and safety to protect and save lives."
