The Role of Health Equity

Session 3 of our Diabetes ELC has been scheduled **for Tuesday, June 28, 1:30-2:30pm**. This session's topic, Prediabetes, Diabetes, & Obesity: The Role of Health Equity, is a great opportunity to learn more about diversity, equity, and inclusion and social determinants of health not only for diabetes but for other chronic diseases.



Learning objectives for this session:

- Learn diabetes and obesity statistics pertaining to Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC)
- Understand the difference between racial and health equity; equity and equality in benefit design
- Learn about unique factors BIPOC face in receiving diagnoses and accessing treatment
- Learn about the employer's role in achieving health equity.

The session's featured speaker, Lauren Josephs, PhD, LMHC, NCC, is an experienced leader in mental

health, research, evaluation, training, strategic planning, quality assurance, diversity, and inclusion. She began working with the Florida Alliance for Healthcare Value in 2020 and leads our efforts to train healthcare providers on quality management, including application of measurement and data in quality improvement efforts, collection of performance data, and use of cultural competence as a quality indicator.

Lauren also serves as Chief Operating Officer and Vice President of Research Evaluation & Training at Visionary Vanguard Group Inc., in Orlando, and served as a Health Disparities Researcher for Florida Hospital (now AdventHealth Orlando).
