HPV is a common virus.

For most, HPV clears on its own. But for others who don't clear the virus, it can cause certain cancers.

There is no way to know which people who have HPV will develop cancer or other diseases.

HPV often has no signs or symptoms,

so people can have the virus, pass it on by sexual contact, and not even know it.

HPV can affect both males and females.

Males are also at risk for certain HPV-related cancers.

HPV can have potentially serious consequences.

HPV can lead to certain cancers in males and females.
