Jack's #1 problem in finding any treatment

Access

Jill





Jack cannot get Jill or Susan to return his calls because their waitlists are 6-9 months (industry average)

Jack



Susan





The wrong, but logical, concern is that steering Jack to Jill will make things worse



access solutions are making quality worse

Health plan's access solution

Susan MUST schedule an appointment within 5 days of Jack's first call to be eligible for higher rates





Jack's chances of knocking on the wrong provider's door first: **84%**



Why is Jack usually seen by Susan?

Everyone is guessing



Susan creates an on-line profile and lists her expertise

Jack does an on-line search related to his needs (depression and work)



Jack believes Susan is a good "match" and contacts her



Self-identified problems are unreliable

BH is the only field of medicine where patients are routinely asked to diagnose themselves.



Tools like the PHQ-9 were designed to sell more SSRI's and have a 50% false positive rate.

The **Treatment Outcome Package**[©] was developed by factor analyzing all diagnostic symptoms on millions of patients across all levels of care.



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





