

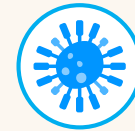
# INFORMATION ON COVID-19 AND FLU



**1** **COVID-19** and **Flu** are both contagious respiratory illnesses **caused by different viruses**, which continue to change.<sup>1,3</sup>



**COVID-19** is caused by a type of **coronavirus** (SARS-CoV-2).<sup>1</sup>



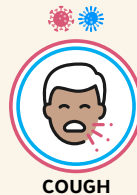
**Flu** is caused by **an influenza virus**.<sup>1</sup>

To help protect against **COVID-19** and **Flu**, different vaccinations are required for each.<sup>1</sup>

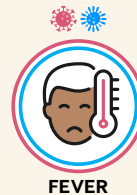
**2** **COVID-19** and **Flu** may have **similar symptoms**.<sup>1</sup>

Talk to a healthcare professional about getting tested for both **Flu** and **COVID-19** if you have symptoms.<sup>1</sup>

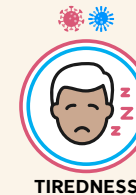
